

I went to the National Library of the Sons of the American Revolution here in Louisville today and found a few bits and pieces of information.

From: *History of Chester County Pennsylvania*, by J. Smith Futhey and Gilbert Cope, Louis H. Everts, Philadelphia 1881

1. An Andrew Gibson is listed as being a private in Capt. C. Wigton's Company, of the Eighteenth Section of Riflemen, commanded by Co. Thomas Humphrey at Camp Snyder, October 11, 1814 on Bush Hill. Also listed was Samuel C. Gibson
2. An Andrew Gibson is listed in the 1753 West Fallowfield taxables.
3. An Andrew Gibson is listed as a West Fallowfield landowner in 1774. Also listed were George Gibson, Alexander Gibson and Sarah Weldon.
4. An Andrew Gibson is listed as owning one slave in 1780.

There are many Gibsons listed. Here are a few:

(This is very interesting. Christian is the daughter of Thomas Harland and Katherine Bullock. She married John Gibson. I am related to Christian Harland Gibson on my father's side. My grandmother was a Harlan. The Gibson's are my wife's family. It sure was a small world. They had two children; Elizabeth who married Thomas Chandler and Thomas who married Hannah Ring. I do not know how these Gibsons are related, but I would sure like to know.)

(Andrew and Margaret had a son named George.)

(One of these must be the son of Andrew and Margaret. None of them are the Thomas Gibson who married Hannah Ring. He died in 1814, probably in Fayette Co., PA.)

1. According to this researcher Andrew (who married Margaret) was born abt 1708 and died October 25, 1803 in West Chester, Chester Co., PA. This is consistent with the probate of his will. Margaret died August 21, 1781 in West Chester, Chester Co., PA.
2. I have found information on the descendants of two of Andrew and Margaret's daughters – Margaret who married William Lyon and Agnes who married James Criswell.

*History and Genealogy of the Weldin Family in America, by Lewis Cass Weldin, 1939*

1. This is the Weldin family of Chester Co., PA.
2. It lists Hannah as the daughter of Joseph Weldin and Margaret Robinson. According to the book, she married Andrew Gibson. This list a son Andrew, but no other children.
3. Jane Gibson (not listed with her last name) is listed as the wife of Jacob Weldin. According to the book, they had two daughters whose first names are not listed. One was the wife of William Harper and the other was the wife of John Wallace. They did not have any other children.
