

VETERAN OF CIVIL WAR PASSES AWAY

**Andrew Gibson Crawford of
First Minnesota Artillery
Dies at Home Here.**

Andrew Gibson Crawford, one of the few survivors of the famous First Minnesota light artillery of Civil war fame, died last evening at his residence here, 381 Waldo avenue. Mr. Crawford was 72 years old and had made Pasadena his home for eleven years. He was a member of John F. Godfrey post of the G.A.R.

Mr. Crawford is survived by his widow, one daughter and three sons, as well as by thirteen grandchildren.

The funeral will be from the residence on Friday morning at 11 o'clock. Burial will be in Mountain View cemetery.
