Humblly Sheweth

That at the said Orphan Court
held at Chester the 20th day of June last your Petitioners
were admitted ~~and~~ appointed Guardians over the Minor
Children of Thomas Gibson late of West Fallowfield
aforesaid deceased. But That for sundry Reasons
it will not ~~suit~~ ~~them~~ to act in that Capacity.

Your Petitioners therefore pray that your
Honours will be pleased to discharge them from
that Trust. Or appoint others in their stead
as to your Honours shall seem meet.
