

**Orphans Court – Chester Co., PA, 20 Jun 1769**

John Kayle and James Adams were appointed guardians of Sam, Jacob and Robert Gibson, petitioners on behalf of themselves and Thomas, George and Mary Gibson, all minor children of Thomas Gibson of West Fallowfield, Chester Co., PA, recently deceased.

**Orphans Court – Chester Co., PA, 19 Sep 1769**

James Adams declined to serve as guardian.

**Orphans Court – Chester Co., PA, December 18, 1770**

James and Mary McCormick and Andrew Gibson, administrators of the estate of Thomas Gibson [another filing refers to Mary and “late Mary Gibson}, reported the sale of the plantation of Thomas Gibson to the court. Thomas Gibson left a widow and seven children as survivors.

\_\_\_\_\_, 1770 George Gibson and William Reed certified as to the above sale to the court.

**Orphans Court – Chester Co., PA, October 7, 1773**

Court document refers to Andrew as being the brother of Thomas.

**Orphans Court – Chester Co., PA, March 25, 1772**

Petition for the division or valuation of real estate of Thomas Gibson, deceased

Children listed, Agnes, Jacob (eldest son), Robert, Thomas, George and Mary. Samuel has apparently already died by this time. Mary, Thomas’ widow, remarried James McCormick.
